Who can enter (Registration deadline is January 24, 2020):

- Artists and artisans of all ages but there will be no categories or levels. Students are encouraged to enter artwork. All pieces will be shown together.
- This includes those engaged in original creation or interpretation in the 2D or 3D visual arts such as painting, drawing, sculpture, installation/conceptual arts, fabric arts, photography, etc. or those engaged in the creation of original and distinctive one-of-a-kind article with a utilitarian purpose such as jewelry, wearable art, pottery, metal fabrication, and more. - One or two pieces may be entered. Pieces may be previously made but represent our region.

Entry requirements for Exhibition Days:

- Artwork must be inspired by and represent the natural or outdoor recreational assets of Clarion, Crawford, Erie, Mercer, Venango, Forest, or Warren Counties.
- Must be appropriately mounted or framed for display.
- Must complete a registration label for each piece of artwork entered.
- Submit a short bio and contact information and a photo of each piece (.jpeg, 300 dpi) for the exhibition booklet.
- There is no entrance fee but CGT will retain 10% commission on the sale of any piece sold during the exhibition event.
- The public will vote for "People's Choice" award.
- The Council on Greenways & Trails reserves the right not to allow a piece to be displayed.
- The exhibition event will be open to the public and pieces must be appropriate for all viewers.

Sale of Artwork:

- Any queries about purchase of the artwork exhibited on event day will be directed to the artist and pricing is the responsibility of the artist including required taxes, etc.
- Proceeds from the sale of exhibition pieces are forwarded by the end of February to the artists except that CGT will retain a 10% commission of each sale.
- One central "cash register" payment location will be provided on site by CGT. Customers will be able to pay in cash, checks, PayPal, or via credit cards.
